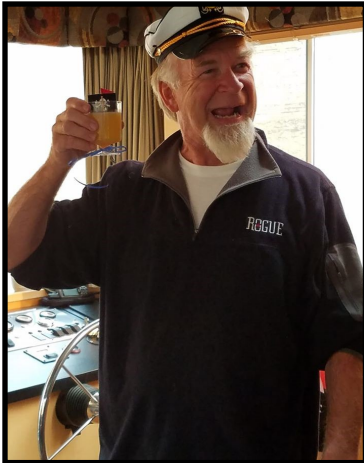
Board Bits:

February– Seafood Chowder– Jay

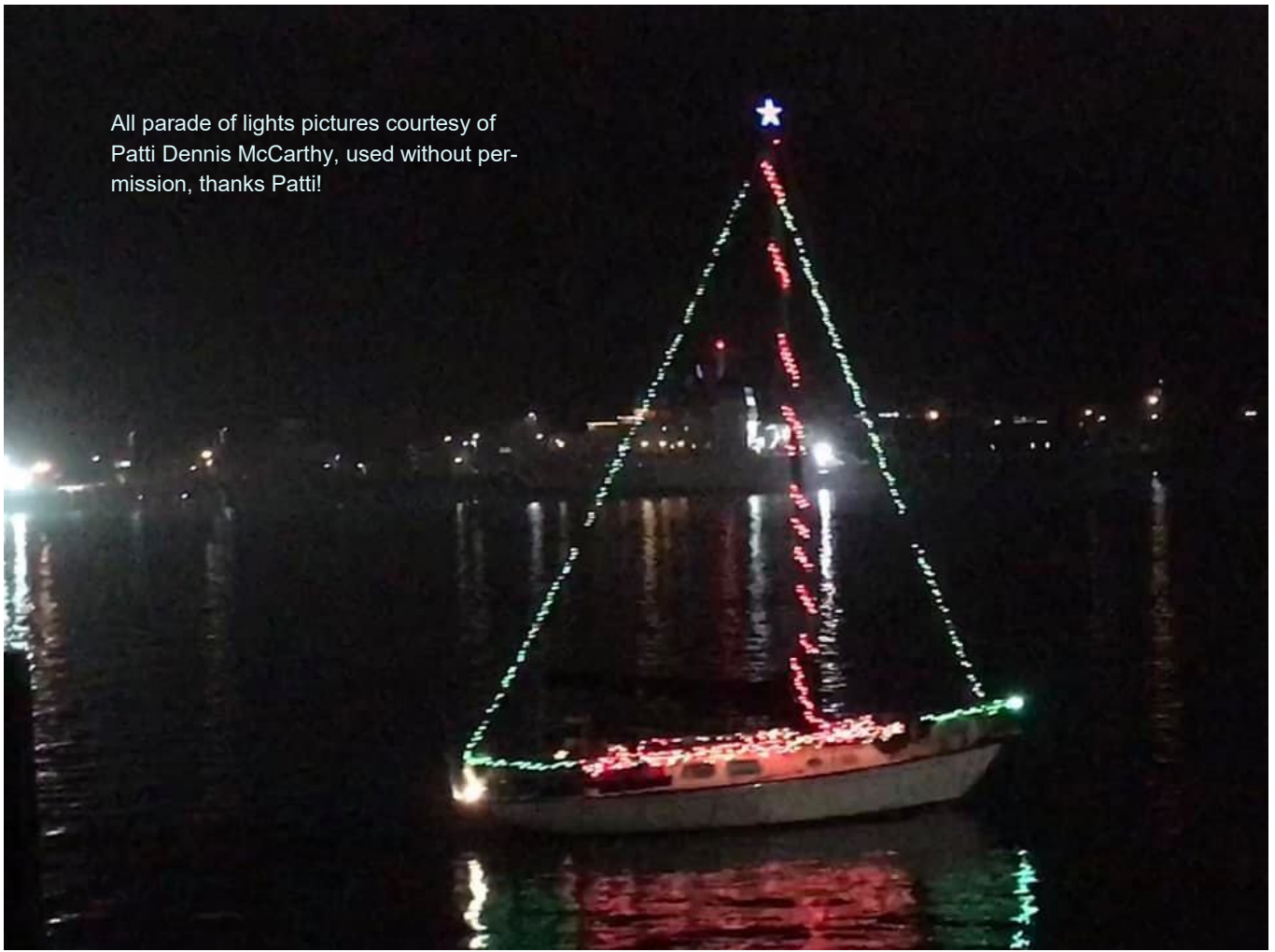
March– December - open except Sailstice (June 20– Mike and Barb)
