Mark your calendar for the Newport Seafood and Wine Festival Thursday-Sunday, February 22-25, 2024. This year's festival theme is "Pacific Wonderland" and YBYC will pair again with Compton Family Winery (<https://www.comptonwine.com/>) out of Philomath for this event which is a fundraiser for us. YBYC sells tastes, glasses, and bottles of Compton wines at the festival and we receive a share of the sales.

Plan to put in a few hours volunteer shift. This is a really great way to experience the festival and support a YBYC fundraiser. Volunteers get to know other YBYC members and the community and receive a festival pass for the whole weekend.
