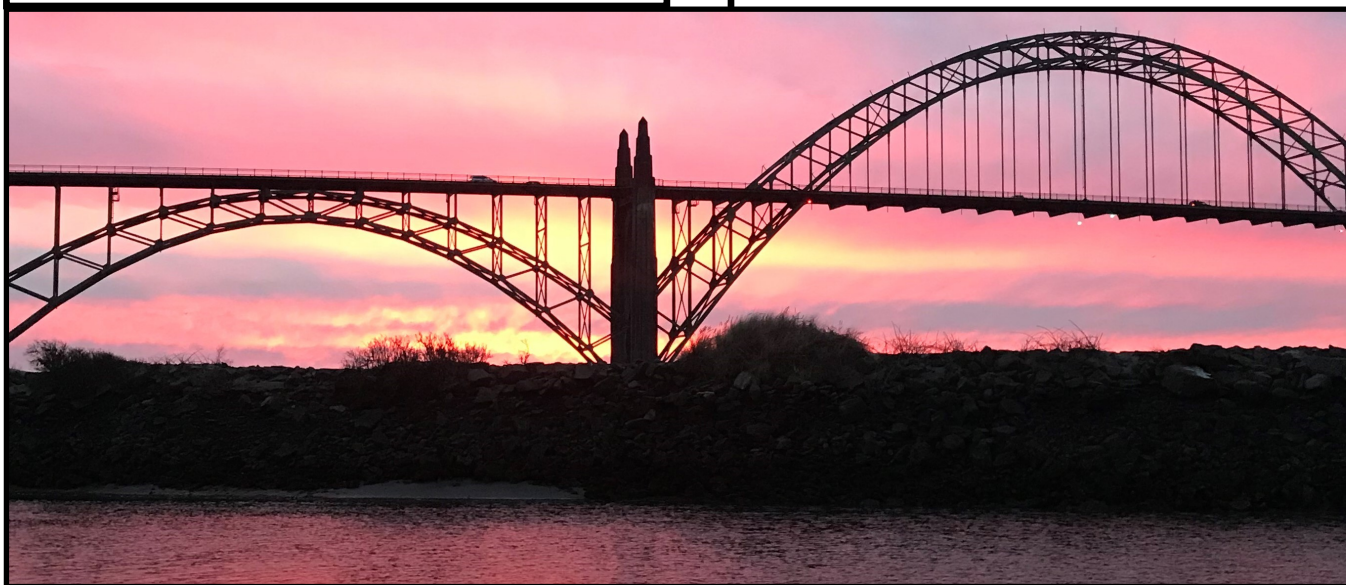
**Need a host** for October 19 meeting, or I guess it will be a no-host potluck... pg 3

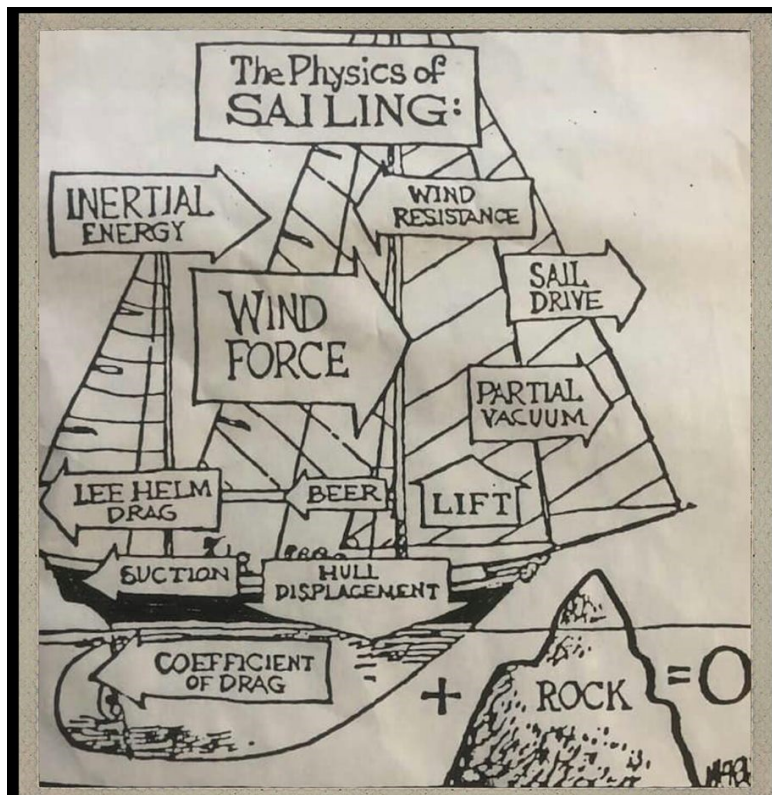
