Dues are pro-rated for new membership applicants. Contact the Membership Chair for an exact figure.

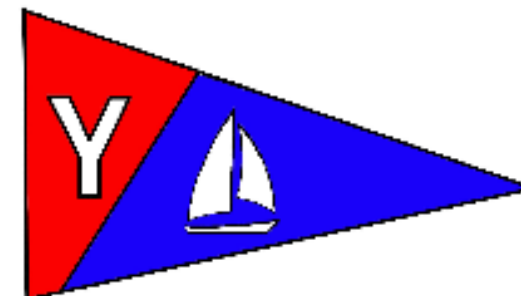
