

The Last Two Education Wednesdays

If you're planning on racing this year, you won't want to miss the final two Wednesday evening programs before the season begins. As a matter of fact, we *really* hope all racers will attend, especially all skippers, because these two programs can mean the difference between a great season and a not so great one.

April 9, beginning at 7:00 pm sharp and lasting only an hour or so, we will be going over the proper functioning of the Committee Boat, a duty which all racers will have the obligation to perform at least once per series. This will include course selection, line length and placement for the conditions, bow and stern anchoring technique to hold a steady position with variable wind and current, and of course the actual process of getting the race going and reporting accurate results. Even if you think you know all this stuff it won't hurt to review it, and it will be as fun as we can make it.

April 23, again at 7 sharp, will be a Rules Refresher session, featuring the animated UK sails rules quiz and a neat little handbook Laurie W. came across that simplifies common situations and the rules that apply. Granted we had unusually light winds last season but we made it through with zero collisions that I know of. Let's all try really hard to repeat that this year and in the future as we all get better at understanding the rules and using protests instead of playing bumper boats. I will make a poll on the Group to see if there is interest in holding a Rules session on the 16th as well, in case some can't make the 23rd or just want two sessions. Again, we'll do our best to make it fun as well as informative, hope to see you there, Skippers!
