### **Learn to sail on Yaquina Bay:**

- No sailing experience needed, just a desire to personally harness the wind for fun
- Class covers sailing fundamentals, sailboat parts, and rigging plus sailing stories
- Also learn about boating safety, weather & tides, navigational aids, plus rules of the road
- Taught in 2 person, Club 420 sailboats (pictured above)
- Classroom sessions at YBYC clubhouse, on-the-water in marina and Yaquina Bay
- Each student is responsible to attend each class session and supply themselves with a light wetsuit, foot gear, gloves, and PFD (life jacket) – don't forget to bring extra clothes and a sack lunch. Note that YBYC has facilities for changing clothes and even a shower.

### **Have fun learning to sail in a constructive, safe, and supportive environment!**

Class Fee: \$450 for non-members, \$225 for YBYC members.\* (payment required by Aug 4; includes instruction book and use of YBYC sailboats and facilities during class periods. Wetsuits & PFDs are NOT provided).

Class size is limited to 12 students.

\*up to 50% of fee can later be applied to 2022 YBYC new membership fees.
