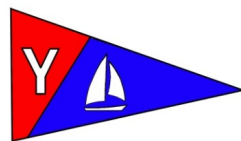

April! Both showers and flowers are here on the coast! Frostbite series has seen good participation through the winter months and draws to a close this month.

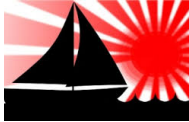

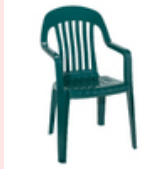
